

German test as part of the entrance examination

As part of the entrance examination, all applicants whose native language is not German have to take a **German test**. Participation is compulsory! The test usually takes part on the same day as the entrance examination for the major subject.

Conditional admission

Persons who have not yet reached level B2, but are able to prove language skills of level B1, may be admitted for studies subject to the condition that they obtain the required language skills by the end of the first subject semester. hmt Rostock provides a specific language course for this purpose. The course objective is to provide students with good German language skills (with a specific focus on music) at level B2 and constitutes a prerequisite for studying at hmt Rostock. The classes in the music theory, teaching of music and musicology modules can only be attended once corresponding language skills have been obtained.

Attending the language class is subject to a fee, which must be paid by the student. The fee per semester is € 930. The DAAD covers around 2/3 of this, so that students only have to pay around € 300 for the semester.

Students' enrolment will be terminated if they are unable to present a certificate as proof of good language skills at level B2 by the end of the first subject semester.

Admission to foundation year

Students unable to prove language proficiency at level B1 can attend a foundation year for a maximum of 2 semesters. The foundation year covers 2 contact hours per week of individual tuition in the major subject. This also includes attending group classes (e.g. orchestra classes and music theory for students on a foundation year) and the use of the library and rehearsal rooms. The foundation year is subject to a fee. The fee per semester amounts to € 800. There will be additional costs for a language course to be chosen by the student. This must be accompanied by one of the following certificates at the required language level:



- *Deutsche Sprachprüfung für den Hochschulzugang ausländischer Studienbewerber Level DSH Stufe I*
- *Deutsches Sprachdiplom der Kultusministerkonferenz - DSD Stufe I*
- *telc-Sprachzertifikat "telc Deutsch B2 Hochschule"*

Submitted certificate may **not be older than 6 months**.

Degree courses with other stipulations:

Different rules apply to the degree courses Music Theory, Musicology, to all teacher-training degree courses, to acting degrees and doctoral candidates. Please refer to the specific study and examination regulations to find out which language requirements must be met.
