ORCHESTRA REHEARSALS

Attached in the other file you find the timeline of the SOMMERCAMPUS with the times of the orchestra rehearsals. The exact order and/or selection of participants rehearsing with the orchestra will be made by the course professors on spot.

REPERTOIRE: From your applications the repertoire with your wishes (selected by the list from the SOMMERCAMPUS Website) was filtered and is now mostly available as final repertoire for the rehearsals.

NOTE: Sponteanous changes into completely new pieces are not possible anymore, unless they are on the final list. In the masterclasses with your professors you can work the entire concertos. For the work with the orchestra only one movement can be regarded.

CONCERTS FESTSPIELE MECKLENBURG-VORPOMMERN: Since potentially every participant can also be selected as a soloist for one of the concerts of the Festspiele Mecklenburg-Vorpommern, we recommend placing additional emphasis also on one movement of 6-10 minutes in length in your artistic work in order to further increase the chance of being selected.

CONDUCTOR: The chief conductor Marcus Bosch is prepared to meet you right after each orchestra rehearsal block for a feedback to your work and also 15 minutes before each orchestra rehearsal block for a small synchronisation (exact times see attached in the other file).



ARTISTIC VITA

Some of you will perform as soloists in the concerts of the Festspiele Mecklenburg-Vorpommern. Please have your artistic vita ready in German as a PDF file so that we can send it in for the programme quickly.
